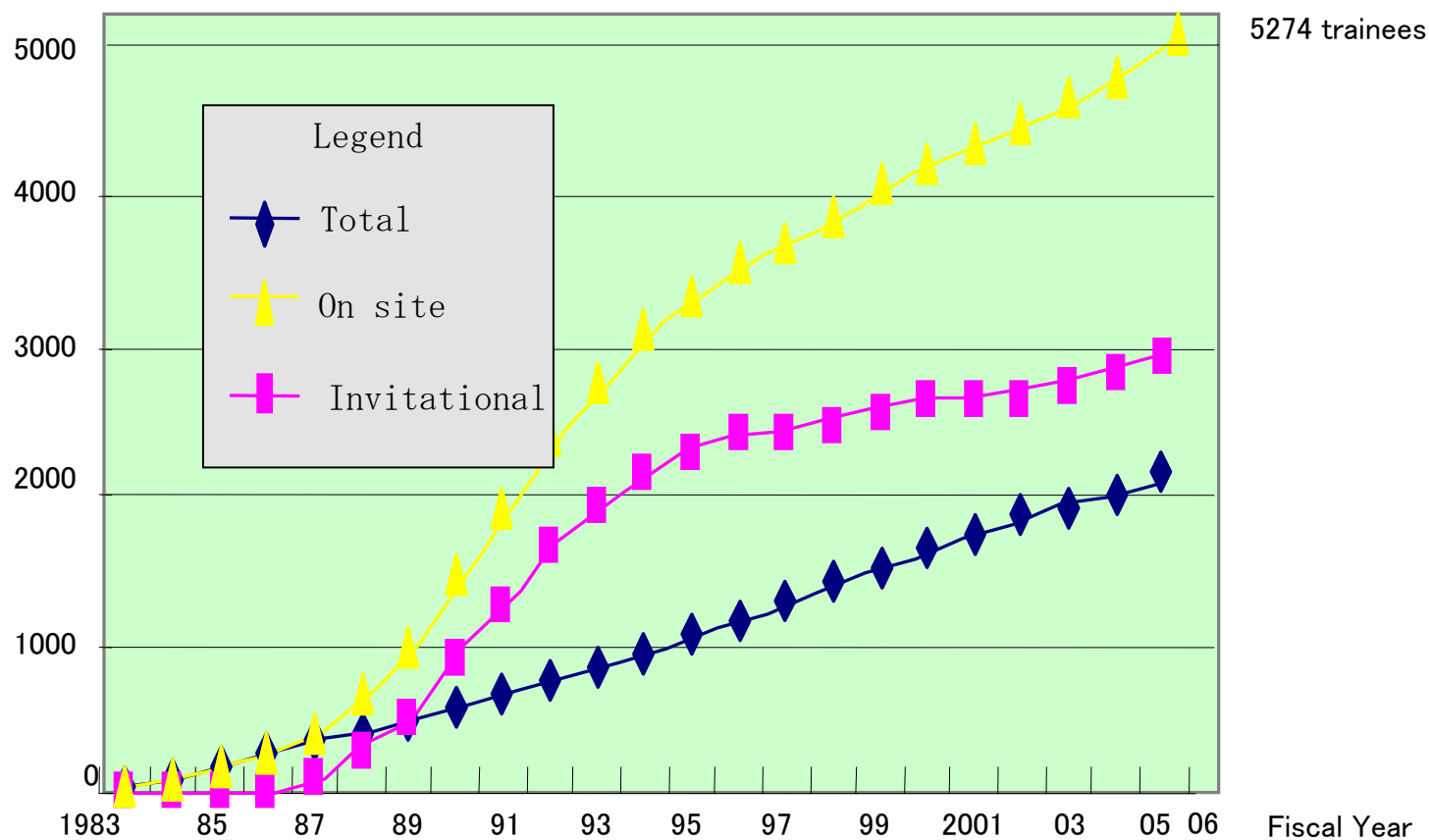

Human resource development in Asia

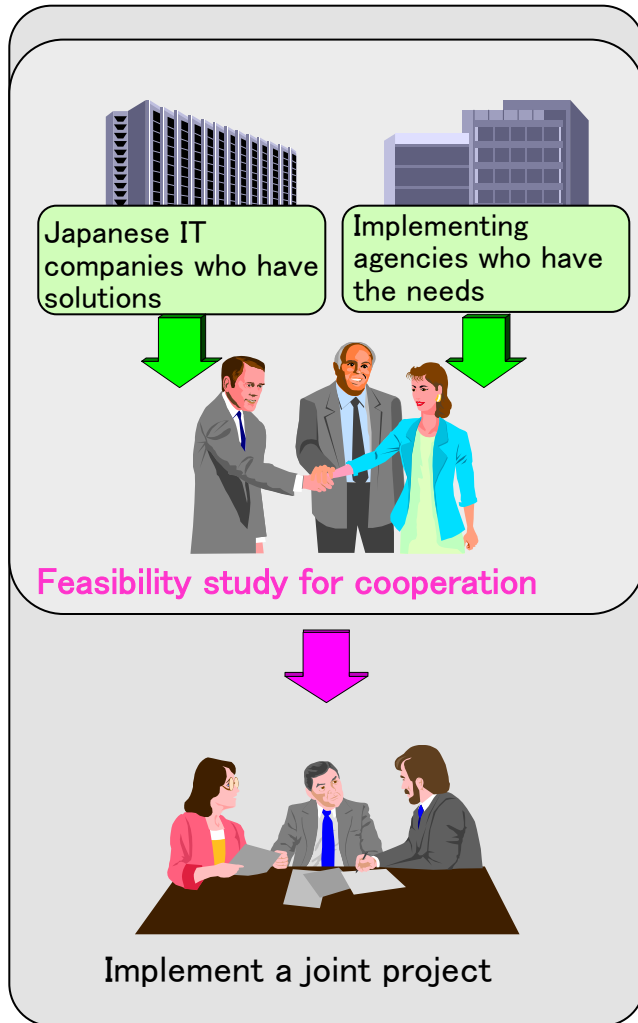
Increment of Number of Certified Trainees (1983-2006)

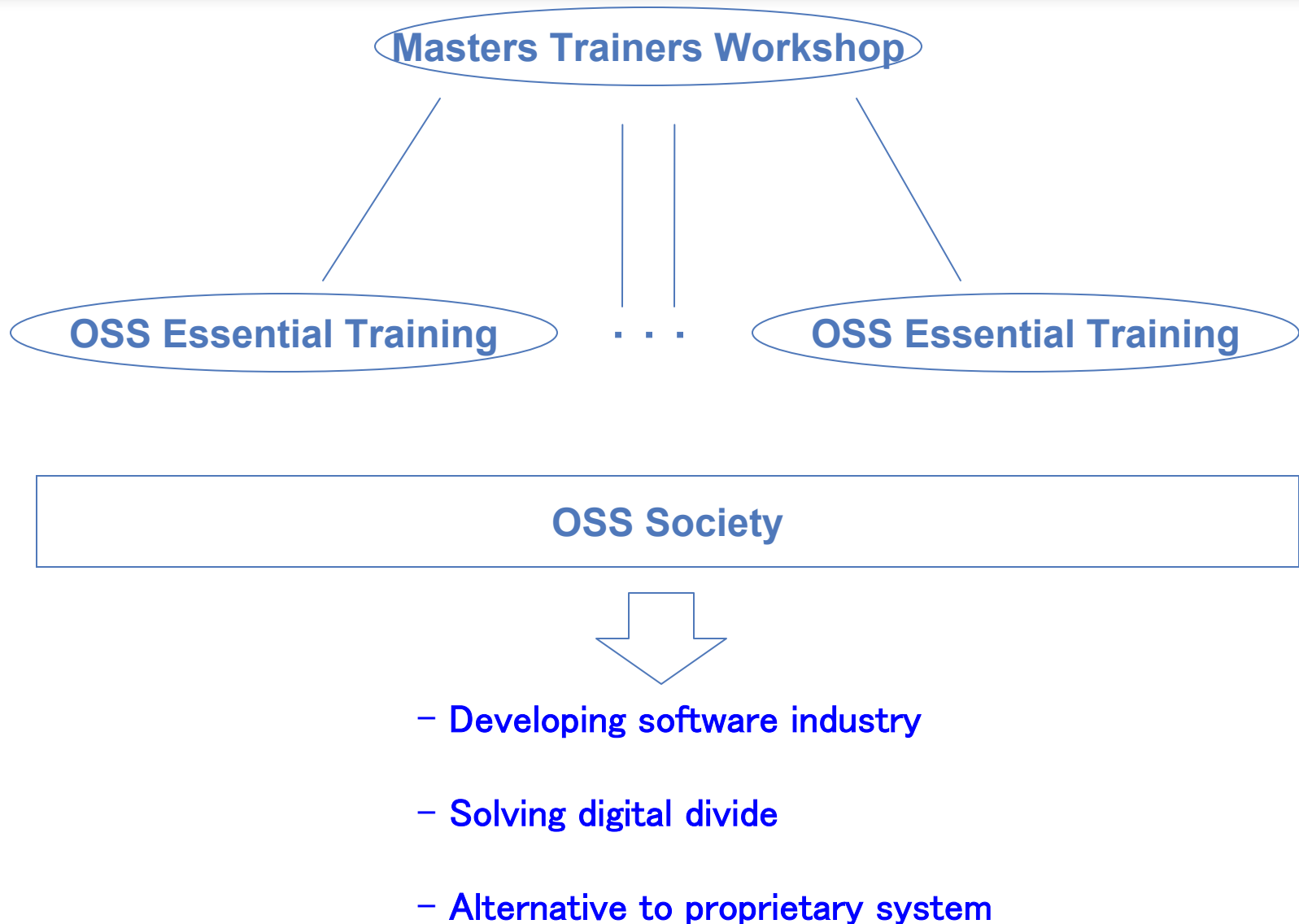

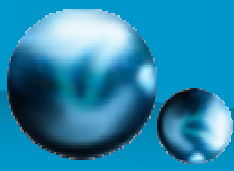
