

To promote the use of Free Open Source:





Localized FOSS


There are already mature localized software in Cambodia such as

Why Localize?

- Low literacy rate in foreign language eg.
 English
- Free License ==> Free to use
- English is no more mandatory for learning computer
- Good for education and non-profit sector
- Localization separates the skills of "English" and "Local Contents".

- Non-Profit Organization

- Business
 - eg. Ubuntu, Joomla
- Education
 - eg. Joomla, Drupal, Ubuntu

FOSS Adoption in Cambodia

- Software Development
 - PHP, Python, Ruby on Rails
 - MySQL, pgSQL
 - Eclipse, Netbeans
 - Joomla, Drupal
 - More...

Why Adopt FOSS?

- The Royal Government of Cambodia encourage to use Open Source Technology. NiDA is the main entity to promote FOSS in Cambodia
- Free choice to learn and improve oneself
- No need to pay propriety license
- There are a lot of community support
- Hand to Hand experience
- Enabling Technology
- Good for student and self learning

Challenges and Difficulties in FOSS Adoption

- Software piracy and illegal software
- Lack of Human Resource in ICT
- Lack of Technical Support
- Poor in communication ways
- Still few OpenSource community
- Lack of financial support
- Lack of awareness and concepts and potential benefits of Open Source Software
